

December 2023The Christmas You Love.

Christmas adverts: love them or loathe them, we are now well and truly in *that* season.

I have seen a few articles criticising this year's M&S Christmas advert, with one person expressing strong disappointment that its portrayal of celebrities 'doing away' with Christmas traditions does not embody the spirit of the season's values.

People get passionate about Christmas adverts. The bar is raised higher each year on companies to think creatively and stand out, whilst simultaneously still reflecting the commercial expectations of portraying the signature festive scenes which 'sell' an image of the ideal Christmas. Having been drawn into the debate through this disapproving view of the M&S Christmas advert, my reflections are that it advocates for leaning away from cultural or corporate expectations, family or societal traditions, and into what is meaningful for you in this season.

Jesus' entry into our world was a humble event: one which was far from the assumptions of an environment that should be fit for a King – both by historic and contemporary standards. Jesus, born in a stable, animals around, with Mary, having travelled heavily pregnant to attend a census – I'd suggest these were far from ideal conditions, and not how a mother might envisage their transition into parenthood.

Over the years we have had many a Christmas that hasn't quite looked the

way we thought it might. The turkey being too dry; plans changing last minute; illness infiltrating get-togethers; and of course, it's still only recently that COVID forced unexpected shifts in plans, hopes and traditions of the season across the globe.

What is 'in the spirit' of Christmas values? As we light each advent candle across our services at MBC this December, we'll reflect on the themes of Hope, Peace, Joy and Love. It's ok that these things may look different for each of us during this season. It's ok that for some of us, love is experienced quietly in contemplation, while for others it's expressed through vibrancy, laughter, and togetherness, or perhaps through the grace and endurance of navigating trickier family dynamics. It's ok that, for some, these themes may not immediately come to mind when considering their own experience or anticipation of this festive period.

Advent symbolises a period of preparation for what – or who – is to come. When Christmas Day arrives, we light a final candle and celebrate Immanuel: 'God with us'. That is, God with us: wherever we are, whoever we are with, whatever our circumstances – expected or unexpected; ideal or imperfect; traditional or unconventional.

Inhale a breath of fresh winter air and breathe a sigh of relief; for at Christmas as we look to Jesus, he invites us, always, to come as we are.

May you experience heavenly peace, and gentle permission to participate in the season in a way that resonates between you and God, this Christmas time.
